### **5. Draft Comprehensive Annual Report Review**

The Committee conducted a review of the draft Comprehensive Annual Report, focusing on Measure H's impacts and areas for ongoing oversight. The Committee recommended including more context in the

Executive Summary, clarifying allocation differences due to administrative costs, and expanding future reporting templates to capture specific areas of interest.

The Committee discussed the use of Measure H funds for pay parity and administrative costs. Members agreed that pay parity will require monitoring over time, and that the parity costs in the first year of implementation were appropriate, as they occurred in smaller districts that had lower pay than urban agencies within the County. The Committee agreed to request more detailed reporting from agencies on parity-related expenditures in future annual reports. Similarly, members acknowledged the importance of administrative capacity, particularly for historically volunteer agencies, while noting the need to track these costs to ensure alignment with the measure's goals.
