4. Executive Director's Report

Director Whitman began her presentation by sharing pictures from a wall-raising ceremony held at the Summer Oaks housing project in Sonoma, noting that the Commission has awarded a significant amount of funding to the project and highlighting the positive outcomes expected upon project completion. Director Whitman also confirmed that a committee meeting will be held in November and December; the committee will consider items related to the Citizen Participation Plan, Permanent Local Housing Allocation (PLHA) program, and the Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER). Director Whitman also shared some updates regarding the Tierra de Rosas housing project in the Roseland neighborhood of Santa Rosa. Director Whitman concluded her presentation by discussing a Board of Supervisors meeting that was held on the evening of October 14th to discuss the potential impact of federal funding cuts, explaining that the Commission's funding will remain level for the current fiscal year.
