Referrals are being accepted.</p> <p>RDA presents final infographic. This year looks much like last year. Recidivism rates across quarters in 2025 ranged from low of 32% to high of 53% recidivism. Successes; Engagement is groing. New enrollments remained stable throughout the year. 69 clients served in 2025.</p>
