Non-Competitive Procurement

Non-competitive procurement. Non-competitive procurement can only be awarded if one or more of the following circumstances apply:

- The good/service is available only from a single source;
- Emergency circumstances;
- The Department expressly authorizes a noncompetitive procurement in response to a written request; or
- After solicitation of a number of sources, competition is determined inadequate.
