HUD will review the application submission in the e-snaps system and score the new project applications on whether or not your project meets the following quality threshold requirements. If you do not include this information in your application in e-snaps, your new project will be rejected by HUD. You must address the criteria in your project application in e-snaps for HUD review. New SSO – Standalone project applications must receive at least 4 out of the 5 points available for this project type. New SSO standalone projects that do not receive at least 4 points will be rejected.
