- **6.1** Advocate at the local and state levels for streamlined processes and increased access to CalFresh (SNAP) and other nutrition benefits
 - Action Team members completed a root cause analysis based on presented data and prioritized strategy.
 - Highlights:
 - Is there a need for additional food resources or is the bigger need to make people aware of resources?
 - Older adults without support are likely to need help applying for CalFresh benefits.
 - There is a stigma associated with asking for help.
 - It may be useful to have additional data around what prevents people from applying for CalFresh.
