- **3.2** Develop and expand mental and behavioral health services including through formal services and peer support groups. (programmatic)
- AT members completed a root cause analysis on strategy 3.2 with consideration for previously reviewed data. Highlights:
 - Are existing services underutilized or is there a need for more services?
 - People may not know how to find services
 - There are trust issue among older adult and stigmas around mental health that contribute to potential underutilization of services.
 - There is a false and harmful belief that depression is normal with aging.
